



Wine, Beer & Spirits List

White Wine

- Sauvignon Blanc 2008, Cumplido Bodegas Altovela (Spain)** £3.75 (175ml) £13.95
Clean and fresh with a light fruity smell, it has a dry taste with a little spiciness and herbs on the palate and a lasting fresh flavour.
- Viognier 2008, Domaine de Mont-Auriol, Vin de Pays de Cotes de Thongue (France)** £17.25
Fragrant aromas but somewhat lighter and drier than its more famous Rhône brothers (Condrieu and Chateau Grillet). Limes, honeysuckle and orange peel with a spicy tinge to the palate.
- Pinot Grigio 2007, Segeshio, Sonoma County (Russian River) California (USA)** £28.50
Purity of fruit combined with scented, spicy character on the nose, good weight and breadth on the palate, as well as a good acid finish makes this wine quite delicious.

Red Wine

- Montepulciano d'Abruzzo 2007, Borgo Thaluero DOC (Italy)** £3.95 (175ml) £14.95
Ethereal bouquet with notes of red fruit, dry, harmonic & full-bodied in flavour.
- Pinot Noir 2008, Omrah, Western Australia (Australia)** £19.50
Excellent example of this delicate grape variety being produced from W.A. Rich, vibrant fruit with a delicate aroma of summer fruits.
- Zinfandel 2007 Segeshio, Sonoma County (Russian River) California (USA)** £28.50
Wow! If you like this grape, this is a truly stunning wine. Rich & full of dense black fruits, made from California's native grape. Awarded 'Best Value Zinfandel' in 'Wine Spectator'.

Rose

- Le Petit Grenache 2008, Paul Jaboulet, Rhone (France)** £3.95 (175ml) £14.95
Vibrant coral pink colour gives way to a clean & delicately scented nose with hints of cranberries & cherries. Soft & rounded on the palate.

Sparkling

- Valdobbiandene, Prosecco dei Conegliano, NV (Italy)** £3.95 (125ml) £19.00
Fruity with an easy charm. Lightly sparkling and full of fresh fruity notes and floral scent. Dry, zesty finish.
- Innocent Bystander, Pink Moscato, NV, Yarra Valley (Australia)** Half bottle (375ml) £8.50
Try this for a bit of fun! Light in alcohol (5.5%), gently frothing with aromas of summer fruits, rose petal & Turkish delight. Slightly sweet but great for an aperitif or to drink alongside a fruit dessert.

Beers

Innis and Gunn (Scotland)	£3.50
<i>A deliciously unique Scottish beer, discovered by accident, that gets its flavours from American oak bourbon casks. Vanilla, toffee and orange aromas mix with a malty oaked palate. Alcohol 6.6%</i>	
Anchor Steam (USA)	£3.50
<i>Very tasty San Francisco micro-brewed beer has a deep amber colour with a thick creamy head. Fruity esters with a nice splash of citrus and caramel. Very unique. Alcohol 4.9%</i>	
Staropramen (Czech Republic)	£3.00
<i>Prague's favourite beer. A smooth tasting Czech Pilsner with a thirst quenching finish, a rich head of foam and a deep golden colour. Alcohol 5.0%</i>

Allt-A-Bhainne Cask Strength Single Malt – 16 yrs in oak cask (Scotland)	(35ml)	£4.50
<i>Rare & different treat – not easily found. Clear complexion; vanilla & floral in smell, dry & sweet to taste. To be enjoyed patiently. Alcohol 55.9%</i>		
Heaven Hill Bourbon – 9 yrs in oak cask (USA)	(35ml)	£4.00
<i>With such heavenly aromas you may just want to smell this one! Caramel mingles deliciously with vanilla. Tastes sweet & smooth followed by a bit of spice. A mighty fine American Bourbon. Alcohol 61.5%</i>

Raspberry Vodka (Scotland)	(35ml)	£4.25
<i>Dangerously drinkable! Light red in colour. Smooth initially with a tiny little bite. Keeps on inviting you back. Fond childhood memories perhaps? Alcohol 22%</i>		
Bramble Scotch Whisky (Scotland)	(35ml)	£4.25
<i>Deep red in colour, initially sweet aniseed flavour, temporarily interrupted by a sting of whisky, then continues on a journey of sweetness with a delicious lingering finish. More please... Alcohol 23%</i>		
Gooseberry Gin (England)	(35ml)	£4.25
<i>Is this a liquid gold? Honey, sweet, smooth and clingy with citrus flavours. Lip smacking good. A lovely & unique summer treat. Alcohol 17%</i>		

Port & Dessert Wine

Muscat de Frontignan, Château de Stony 2005 Languedoc (France) –375ml bottle	£4.95 (125ml)	£13.75
<i>Lighter & slightly less sweet than traditional dessert wine, this wine is the essence of summer. Highly perfumed with honey and orange marmalade fruit-- rich and floral on the finish. Just try to have one glass... Alcohol 15%</i>		
Qunito do Infantado Port LBV 2004 (Portugal)	(100ml)	£3.95
<i>This 2004 was bottled in 2008 and aged four years in cask to mellow the concentrated dark fruits & ripe tannins, producing a smooth port with plenty of berry characters & finesse. Unfiltered. Alcohol 20%</i>
