

Wine, Beer & Spirits List

White Wine

Chenin Blanc 2009, Ormer Bay, Fair Trade Reserve (South Africa) £3.95 (175ml) £14.95

A zesty upfront wine in true New World style. Lime, lemon and grapefruit are much in evidence on the nose. The palate is fuller and rounder with white peach, lychee and crisp green apple.

Picpoul-de-Pinet 2008, Domaine de Saint Peyre, Coteaux du Languedoc (France) £4.50 (175ml) £17.95

Made from 100% Piquepoul grapes, this zesty, fragrant wine offers plenty of fresh citrus & mineral flavours. Perfect as an aperitif, or paired with salads, fish or seafood.

Chardonnay 2007, Estancia Pinnacles Ranches, Monterey, California (USA) £5.25 (175ml) £19.95

Chardonnay grapes lightly oaked (one-third of grapes) & then blended with small additions of Viognier & Riesling producing wine with increased aromas & exotic touch combining well with creamy, ripe finish.

Pinot Grigio 2007, Estancia Pinnacles Ranches, Monterey, California (USA) £22.95

Juicy & richly flavoured wine, bursting with pear, white peach, pippin apples & crisp citrusy notes. Short time spent in neutral French oak which adds to the richness of the mouth-feel.

Viognier 2009, Cline Cellars, Carneros, Sonoma County, California (USA) £24.95

Big pineapple, peach & apricot flavours mixed with citrus and floral notes. This full-bodied flavourful wine is an excellent match for slightly spicy dishes.

Sauvignon Blanc 2008, Duckhorn Vineyards, Napa Valley, California (USA) £34.95

Vibrant acidity balanced by toasted oak & a rich mouth-feel. Aromas of ripe melon, Meyer lemon, kiwi & pineapple complemented by jasmine, honey & hint of spice. Interesting mix of tropical & citrus notes.

Red Wine

Montepulciano d'Abruzzo 2007, Borgo Thaluero DOC (Italy) £3.95 (175ml) £15.95

Ethereal bouquet with notes of red fruit, dry, harmonic & full-bodied in flavour.

Jumilla 2008, Finca de Luzon (Spain) £5.25 (175ml) £19.95

Blend of 65% Monastrell & 35% Syrah. Full-throttle effort with crème de cassis, liquorice, truffle, & exotic intense flavours. Yummy & very easy drinking wine that pairs well with most meat dishes.

Pinot Noir 2008, Omrah, Western Australia (Australia) £5.50 (175ml) £20.95

Excellent example of this delicate grape variety being produced from W.A. Rich, vibrant fruit with a delicate aroma of summer fruits.

Syrah 2007, Cline Cellars, Carneros, Sonoma County, California (USA) £23.95

Deep red-purple colour explodes with interesting flavours from the glass. Cracked black pepper aromas complement the black cherry fruitiness with a hint of vanilla.

Cabernet Sauvignon 2006, Hawk Crest of Stags Leap Cellars, California (USA) £27.50

50/50 CabSav grapes from Paso Robles & Red Hills north of Napa Valley. Dark & intense with concentrated aromas of red currant fruit that mingle with cocoa powder & earthy character from volcanic origins in the Red Hills. Lovely, long vanilla oak finish.

Zinfandel 2007 Segeshio, Sonoma County (Russian River) California (USA) £33.95

Wow! If you like this grape, this is a truly stunning wine. Rich & full of dense black fruits, made from California's native grape. Awarded 'Best Value Zinfandel' in 'Wine Spectator'.

Rosé wine

Le Petit Grenache 2008, Paul Jaboulet, Rhone (France) £4.25 (175ml) £16.95

Vibrant coral pink colour gives way to a clean, delicately scented nose with hints of cranberries & cherries.

Sparkling Wine

Valdobbiandene, Prosecco dei Conegliano, NV (Italy) £3.95 (125ml) £19.00
Fruity with an easy charm. Lightly sparkling and full of fresh fruity notes and floral scent. Dry, zesty finish.

Innocent Bystander, Pink Moscato, NV, Yarra Valley (Australia) Half bottle (375ml) £ 8.50
Try this for a bit of fun! Light in alcohol (5.5%), gently frothing with aromas of summer fruits, rose petal & Turkish delight. Slightly sweet but great for an aperitif or to drink alongside a fruit dessert.

Beers & Cider

Innis and Gunn (Scotland) £ 3.50
A deliciously unique Scottish beer, discovered by accident, that gets its flavours from American oak bourbon casks. Vanilla, toffee and orange aromas mix with a malty oaked palate. Alcohol 6.6%

Sierra Nevada Pale Ale (USA) £ 3.50
Deep amber colour and an exceptionally full-bodied, complex character. Generous quantities of premium Cascade hops give the Pale Ale its fragrant bouquet and spicy flavour. Alcohol 5.6%

Staropramen (Czech Republic) £ 3.00
Prague's favourite beer. A smooth tasting Czech Pilsner with a thirst quenching finish, a rich head of foam and a deep golden colour. Alcohol 5.0%

Thatcher's Gold Apple Cider (England) £ 3.50
Crisp & refreshing with smooth 'appley' taste & bright golden sparkle. A true British favourite. No need for ice. Alcohol 4.8%

Bowmore Cask Strength Single Malt - 17 years old (Scotland) (35ml) £ 4.00
Well balanced Islay Whisky—not too peaty like some neighbours. To smell: smoky sweet, tar, burning embers & medicinal. The taste: dry smoke, burning embers, smoked fish (kippers), sweet & round. Enjoyable for both the Islay beginner & the Islay Fanatic! Alcohol 54.8%

Heaven Hill Bourbon – 9 yrs in oak cask (USA) (35ml) £ 3.50
With such heavenly aromas you may just want to smell this one! Caramel mingles deliciously with vanilla. Tastes sweet & smooth followed by a bit of spice. A mighty fine American Bourbon. Is this a challenger to Scotland's finest whiskies? Alcohol 61.5%

Rhubarb Vodka (Inverness, Scotland) (35ml) £ 3.00
Dangerously drinkable! There's no mistaking the fruity base to this light, fresh, organic Scottish liqueur. Try it in a glass of prosecco as an aperitif. Alcohol 20%

Nelson's Spiced Rum (Glasgow, Scotland) (35ml) £ 3.00
A clever blend of Demerara Rum from the Caribbean, caramel and spices combine to produce the most wonderful taste imaginable; extremely smooth. Delicious in coffee as well as an after dinner tippie. Alcohol 22.9%

Chocolate Orange Cream (Devon, England) (35ml) £ 3.00
Made from a subtle blend of dark chocolate, real Devonshire Cream, Apple Brandy and the zest of an orange. The result is outstanding, liquid chocolate orange! Few will be able to resist the devilish attraction of this deliciously smooth liqueur. Ask for it neat or over ice. Alcohol 17%

<i>Luscious & full flavoured dessert wine packed with soft ripe fruit flavours & has a wonderful sweetness that makes it the perfect partner to a wide range of desserts or simply enjoy it by itself as an aperitif. Alcohol 13.5%</i>		
Remy Martin Cognac VSOP (France)	(35ml)	£ 3.50
<i>An amber Champagne Cognac with a fresh, full nose with notes of vanilla, oak, dried rose & apricot. Very mellow with a short, slightly warm finish. Alcohol 40%</i>		
Quinto do Infantado Port LBV 2004 (Portugal)	(75ml)	£ 3.50
<i>This 2004 was bottled in 2008 and aged four years in cask to mellow the concentrated dark fruits & ripe tannins, producing a smooth port with plenty of berry characters & finesse. Unfiltered. Alcohol 20%</i>		
Boal 10 Yr Madeira, Barbeito (Portugal)	(50ml)	£ 3.75
<i>Fantastic balance between acidity & sweetness. Only cask-aged wines used to produce a wonderful varietal character with natural caramelization & nutty undertones. Alcohol 19%</i>
